Insist on broader scrutiny of spending and investment decisions, providing greater transparency, wider consultation, and more accountability.



#### BETTER COMMUNITIES

Consult residents in the inner wards about setting up their own Parish or Town Councils to give them a greater part in decisionmaking for their areas. Increase collaboration between Borough, Parish and Town Councils to work more effectively together particularly on environmental matters.


